

Special and Emergency Board Meeting

Special meetings may be convened by order of the chairperson, upon request of three Board members or by common consent of the Board members. The district clerk will post notice at least 24 hours before such a meeting is to be convened.

The purpose of special meetings is to give the Board an opportunity to gather information and to discuss and fully explore various aspects of an issue.

Emergency meetings may be called only when the business cannot be handled by or cannot wait for a special meeting. Telephone calls to interested parties must be made, particularly to groups or individuals if their concerns are to be discussed.
