### **NON-SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF COLLEGE CREDITS**

In the case of a student, who has willfully and with appropriate consents (student, parent, college advisor, and teacher) as verified through the college program consent form, does not complete all enrolled college courses with a grade of "C" or better the student will not be allowed to enroll in future college credit programs at the district expense.

Students may enroll in subsequent college credits at the pre-paid expense of their family. These students will still be entitled to all supports afforded the other students in the program. If the student is able to successfully complete these courses with a grade of "C" or better, the family will be reimbursed the tuition for the term and the student will be re-admitted to the college credit program as a student in good standing.

If the student has two non-successful completions during the course of their high school career, they will be permanently removed from further consideration of participation in the college credit program.
