## CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

The ultimate responsibility and authority for curriculum rests with the Board. The Board, however, relies heavily upon the professional judgment and recommendation of teachers. District administrators must have adequate and timely information of several kinds regarding proposed curricular changes.

For this reason, the superintendent and curriculum personnel should be involved through the change process.

The Board shall see that the courses of study prescribed by law and by the rules of the State Board of Education are carried out. The administration may establish supplemental courses which are not inconsistent with the prescribed courses, and may adopt courses of study in lieu of state courses of study upon approval by the Superintendent of Public Instruction.
